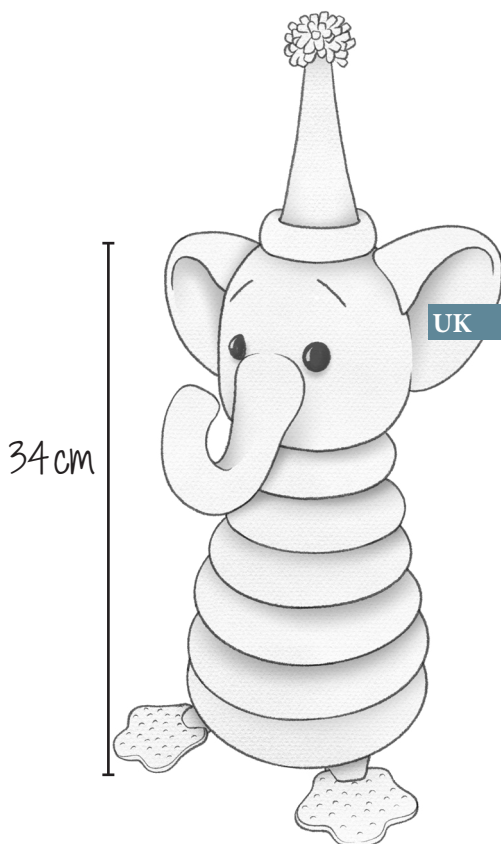
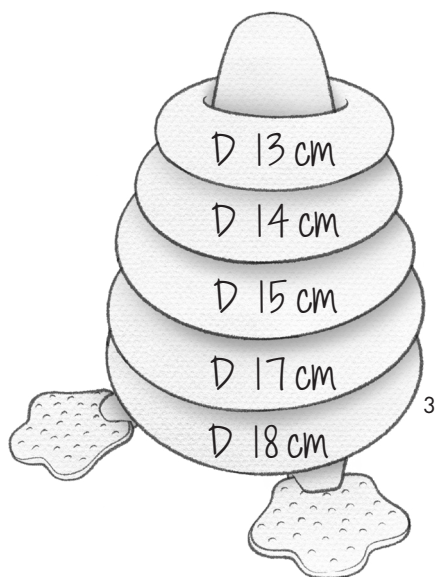
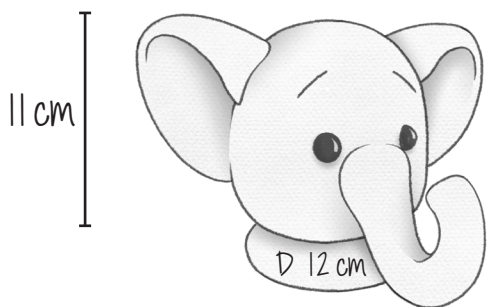

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The gauge must be correct so the rings will be placed harmoniously and well on the cone.

Especially the bottom big ring must be able to stay on the cone. If, for example, it is crocheted to loose or tight, it can be adjusted by making more or fewer rounds at the last rings at the top.

The Stacking animals consist of:

Rings in different sizes.

The top ring is mounted on the head to ensure stability.

At the bottom ring, the TPE Paws are sewn on.

The cone consists of two crocheted parts sewn together around the cone.

Head with parts – ears, snout, trunk, mule, hairband, cap or hat.

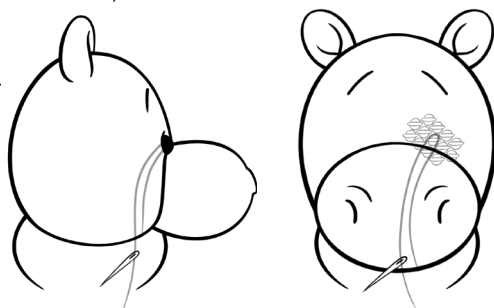
Fill with filling.

Cut the yarn, pull the thread through the stitches, tighten and sew the head closed.

Eye Socket:

With Happy Chunky yarn thread a needle with approx. 25 cm yarn. Put the needle in from under the chin and out at the inner side of the eye. Sew through a st, bring the needle to the second eye, return to the first eye and back again. Guide the needle out under the chin. Tighten the thread so that the pressure forms a hollow. To keep the pressure on the hollow, sew through a couple of sts under the chin. The eyesockets are now made for both eyes. Embroider eyebrows.

- 1.) Ch 11, 2 dc in the second ch from the hook, 8 dc, 3 dc in the last ch.
9 dc on the opposite side of the ch (22)
- 2.) *1 dc inc, 10 dc* (24)
- 3.) *2 x 1 dc inc, 2 dc, 1 dc inc, 4 dc,
1 dc inc, 2 dc* x 2 (32)
- 4.) *1 dc inc, 1 dc, 1 dc inc, 1 dc,
1 dc inc, 5 dc, 1 dc inc, 5 dc* x 2 (40)
5. - 8.) 40 dc (40)
- 9.) 3 dc, *1 dc dec, 8 dc* x 3,
1 dc dec, 5 dc (36)
10. - 11.) 36 dc (36)

Close with 1 sl st.

Fill with filling as you go.

Sew the snout right under the eyes.

NOSTRILS 2 X

Color A.

- 1.) mr with 6 dc (6)

Close with 1 sl st.

Sew onto the snout.

EARS 4 X

Color A.

- 1.) Ch 5, 1 tr in the third st from the hook, 1 htr, in the last ch make 1 dc, 1 picot.
On the opposite side of the chain crochet
1 dc, 1 htr, 1 tr

Finish the first 2 ears.

Place 2 ears wrong side facing and crochet them together as follows:

- 2.) Ch 1, 9 dc (9)

Sew the ears onto the head.

HAIRBAND

- 2.) 1 dc inc, 1 dc, 1 dc inc, 1 t-ch (5)

- 4.) 7 dc, 1 t-ch (7)
- 5.) 1 dc dec, 3 dc, 1 dc dec (5)
- 6.) 1 dc dec, 1 dc, 1 dc dec (3)
- 7.) 3 dc together, 1 t-ch (1)
8. - 65.) 1 dc (1)

Measure around the head – remember it is flexible.

- 66.) 3 dc in same st, 1 t-ch (3)
- 67.) 1 dc inc, 1 dc, 1 dc inc, 1 t-ch (5)
- 68.) 1 dc inc, 3 dc, 1 dc inc, 1 t-ch (7)
- 69.) 7 dc (7)
- 70.) 1 dc dec, 3 dc, 1 dc dec (5)
- 71.) 1 dc dec, 1 dc, 1 dc dec (3)
- 72.) 3 dc together (1)

Tie a knot right before the 2 "leaves".

Sew the hairband onto the head.

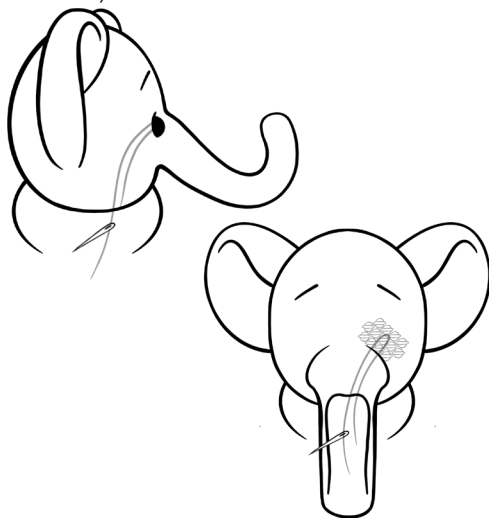

Fill the trunk with filling.

Sew the trunk onto the head as follows:

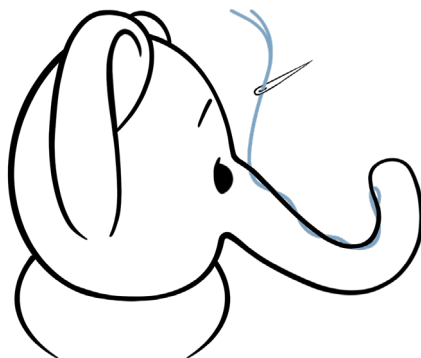
Turn the 8 sl st downwards and the upper part of the trunk is sewn on so it aligns with the row between the eyes.



Cut a thread of approximately 60 cm.

Thread the needle with both ends. Sew through a st at the end of the trunk. Pull the ends through the loop. Sew through the sts on the upper side of the trunk.

Finally, sew under the same st again, to attach the thread.



EARS X 2

POMPON FOR THE HAT

Color C.

The pompon is made on for example a fork. Wrap the yarn around the fork 30 times. A yarn end of 30 cm is used to tie the loops together in the middle so they can be removed from the fork. The loops are cut up so the pompon is round.

Sew to the top of the hat.

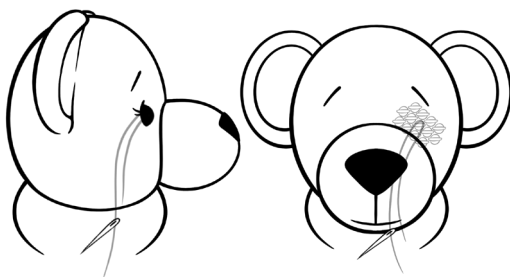

- 3.) 1 dc inc x 2, 3 dc, 1 dc inc x 2, 3 dc, 1 dc inc x 2, 6 dc (24)
- 4.) 1 dc, 1 dc inc x 2, 5 dc, 1 dc inc x 2, 5 dc, 1 dc inc x 2, 7 dc (30)
- 5.) 1 dc, 1 dc inc x 2, 7 dc, 1 dc inc x 2, 7 dc, 1 dc inc x 2, 9 dc (36)
- 6.) 36 dc (36)
- 7.) 12 dc, 1 dc dec x 2, 20 dc (34)

Turn, work in rows from here.

- 3.) *1 dc, 1 dc inc*, 1 t-ch (15)

- 4.) *2 dc, 1 dc inc*, 1 t-ch (20)

Finish color B.

Place color B and A wrong side facing and crochet together with color A as follows:

- 5.) 20 dc (20)

Sew the ears onto the head.

Good to know

Hook Size + Tension

Crocheters crochet very differently: some crochet with a hook size 2,0 mm and obtain the same size of design and quality as a person who crochets with a hook size 4,0 mm. We owe this knowledge to the team of crocheters who join us. The key to crochet a specific size is a lot about the crochet style/hands/skills, rather than the size of hook. Therefore, we will recommend a range of hook sizes.
